**Re:** Early Retiree Reinsurance Program (ERRP)

## The following information is only for TLC groups that offer Early Retiree Coverage:

The Department of Health and Human Services (HHS) has issued an interim final rule implementing the temporary Early Retirement Reinsurance Program (Program) established by the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act (PPACA) as part of the Health Care Reform Law. The Program, which has an overall funding limit of \$5 billion, starts on June 1, 2010, and will expire on January 1, 2014 (or when the \$5 billion funding allocation is exhausted, whichever comes first). The Program provides reimbursement to participating sponsors of employment-based plans for a portion of the costs of providing health coverage to early retirees age 55 and older who are not eligible for Medicare, and their eligible spouses, surviving spouses, and dependents. The Program will apply to claims incurred on or after June 1, 2010 in plan years ending after that date that fall between the cost threshold and the cost limit for the plan year.

While a significant amount of further clarification is needed before an application can be submitted, an overall program description prepared by Aon Consulting is attached along with an *Aon Alert* summary of the guidance issued by HHS.
