New Name Coming for the Local Choice Health Plan Prescription Drug Benefit

Key Advantage and TLC HDHP plan members will see a new name beginning in January for their prescription drug benefit. The Anthem pharmacy benefit manager, IngenioRx, will change its name to CarelonRx on January 1, 2023.

The name change will not impact members' benefits, coverage, ID cards, or how they fill their prescriptions. Members can continue to fill their prescriptions at any in-network retail pharmacy. They will not need new prescriptions for current medications.

Members will notice the new name if they leverage home delivery and specialty pharmacy services. IngenioRx Home Delivery Pharmacy will become CarelonRx Mail and IngenioRx Specialty Pharmacy will become CarelonRx Specialty Pharmacy. Starting in October, members who already leverage these services will begin receiving package inserts alerting them to the name change that will go into effect January 1. From mid-November through mid-December, members using home delivery and specialty pharmacies will receive a letter reminding them of the pharmacy name change.

Members will continue to access their pharmacy information through <u>anthem.com</u> and via Sydney Health. If members have questions about their pharmacy benefits, they should call the number on the back of their ID card.

Optima Health Will Change Prescription Drug and Vision Vendors in 2023

Members can expect the following:

- Optima Health will continue to use Proprium for specialty tier 4 medications
- Continued access to a robust national pharmacy network
- Active pharmacy pre-authorizations automatically transferred

- A wider selection of vision providers with more access points and several retail locations
- Opportunity to participate in a discount program called Exam Plus Savings Pass

Optima Health will notify all members by letter before the changes are effective.
